Dear Parents and Carers,

On account of the rapidly worsening humanitarian situation in Ukraine and the amount of concern amongst our staff and children, we will be holding a non-uniform day on Friday 25th March as well as raising awareness through SMSC lessons, assemblies and other activities in school, both on this day and beyond.

All children will be able to wear appropriate non-school uniform on this day. We are asking for children and staff to wear yellow and blue to support the appeal.

Disaster Emergency Committee is being supported by the UK Government who have said that they will match the donations by the public to this appeal.

DEC charities and their local partners are in Ukraine and in neighbouring countries providing food, water, shelter and medical assistance.
