# To coincide (verb)

## Definition:

**Root:** early 18th century (in the sense 'occupy the same space'): from medieval Latin *coincidere*, from *co-* 'together with' + *incidere* 'fall upon or into'.

## Synonyms:

1. Occur simultaneously, happen together.
2. Tally, correspond, agree, concur.

## Example:

1. The parents coincided their holidays with their children's school holidays.
2. Our views coincide on a range of subjects.
