Dear Parent/Carer


We have been informed by Wakefield Council that there will be closure to the road outside school for 3 weeks from November 20<sup>th</sup> on weekdays only. The Highways Dept have informed us that work will be carried out on Spawd Bone Lane between England Lane and Womersley Road. Highways are telling us that the road will be closed during the times that School is in session (8.25am – 2:30pm) We believe this will mean that parents will struggle to access the school by car during these times. We are therefore advising that if a student currently travels to school in a car that alternative arrangements are made for drop off and pick up.

As the weather has changed significantly recently, we have noticed students attending school without a coat which is obviously not advisable. Please encourage your children to wear coats to attend school at this time of year. We want to support all families; if any family is struggling for a waterproof coat this winter, please do get in touch and let us know.

It has been brought to our attention that vapes containing THC are currently circulating among some young people. Please note that students must not carry any kind of vape, bring them to school or use them. When vapes are found on students, parents will be informed and the vapes taken away.
